

SLCA Clubhouse RV and Travel Trailer Use Rules

Rev 1.0 as approved by the SLCA Board at their meeting 6AUG21

Camping at the SLCA Clubhouse is a benefit to SLCA members who have visitors arriving in a camper, travel trailer, or 5th wheel. SLCA will allow up to two camp setups at any time.

Sponsor – Campers must have an active SLCA member as their sponsor. The SLCA member will be responsible for any fees incurred and the activities and actions of the camper, including any costs associated with site repair or clean-up after the departure of the campers.

Rates – Rates are \$30 per night, payable at the time of making the reservation.

Cancellations – Cancellation before 14 days of the arrival will result in a full refund. Cancellations after 14 days will result in a 50% cancellation fee.

Maximum stay – Use is limited to 7 consecutive nights.

Check-in/check-out – Campers should not arrive before 2 pm, campers should depart by 11 am.

Maximum campers – 6 people per site is the maximum, all must sleep in the camper.

Water – Water is provided at your parking site for filling your tanks or for camper connection.

Power – 30A 110 Vac Power is provided at your parking site for use in your camper.

Sewer – No sewer connections are provided. The camper must haul away any waste created.

Tank dumping – Tank dumping is prohibited; this includes black water, gray water, and fresh water tanks. There is a dump station at the rest stop on State Route 8 (east bound) between Elma and McCleary.

Toilets – The Clubhouse toilets and any porta-potties are off-limits to campers. These facilities are there for the membership use during SLCA events. Please use your camper's toilet facilities.

Garbage/Trash – Campers must haul away any and all refuse. There is no waste disposal available on-site.

Pets – Pets are welcome but must be on a leash and under the direct control of the owner. The owner shall clean up any pet waste and take it away with their other refuse. Campers are encouraged to take their pets on walks away from the clubhouse and parking areas.

SLCA amenities use – Use of the recreational facilities (basketball, pickleball, horseshoes, etc..) is permitted. Camping guests must share these facilities with other SLCA members who may visit the grounds. Rental of an RV spot DOES NOT include use of the clubhouse building.

Campfires – Campfires are not allowed.

Fireworks – Fireworks are not allowed on the property.

Grills – self-contained grills may be used. These must be propane/butane fueled. Wood or charcoal cooking fires or grills are prohibited.

Washing/rinsing – Washing or rinsing of RVs, campers, cars, tow-vehicles, etc. is prohibited.

Maintenance - Maintenance of RVs, campers, cars, tow-vehicles, etc. is prohibited.

Quiet time – Quiet time is 8pm until 8am.

Generator use – Generators may be used, but not during quiet time.

Tents – Not allowed. Tent campers are encouraged to stay at their SLCA sponsors property.

Violations – Campers found to be in violation of any of the above rules may be directed to depart the property by the SLCA. Violators will forfeit all prepaid fees.

Animals and food storage – Bears, cougars, coyotes, foxes, racoons, and other native animals live around Summit Lake. Campers are required to store all food or other potential attractors inside their vehicles.

Liability – By the use of the property, the camper agrees to the above terms and also releases SLCA and its board and membership from any liability or responsibility for loss or damage incurred while at the clubhouse or SLCA property.
